Like the resilient juniper it is named for, The Griot and Grey Owl Black Southern Writers Conference plants itself in the rich soil of Durham, NC as a 3-day culturally immersive conference from November 3rd - 5th, 2023. We've learned via polling that 90% of Black southern writers were in desperate need of true sodality after the pandemic left us isolated, depleted, and uninspired. Heeding the call, G&G was formed to revitalize the untended soil in our minds without the assistance of competition and othering. Here at G&G, we know that while we may write alone, when we create together, we truly blossom.

Our mission is trifold: we aim to build stewards of the literary craft throughout the South by intentionally sowing the seeds of comradery, indispensability, and cultural significance. 
Did you know that

Of all writers in the US are Black/People of Color?

However, only

5%

Of books written by Black people in the US, since 1950, have been published.



In 2020, we saw a record 26.3% of bestsellers written by black authors. In 2021, this fell by almost a third down to 18.0%, below even 2019 levels.
